If your provider ordered laboratory testing today, you will receive an Explanation of Benefits (EOB) from your insurance company. It is important to remember this is not a bill. The explanation of benefits (EOB) is a statement of services provided. A separate patient statement will be mailed if a copay, coinsurance, or deductible is due on your account.
